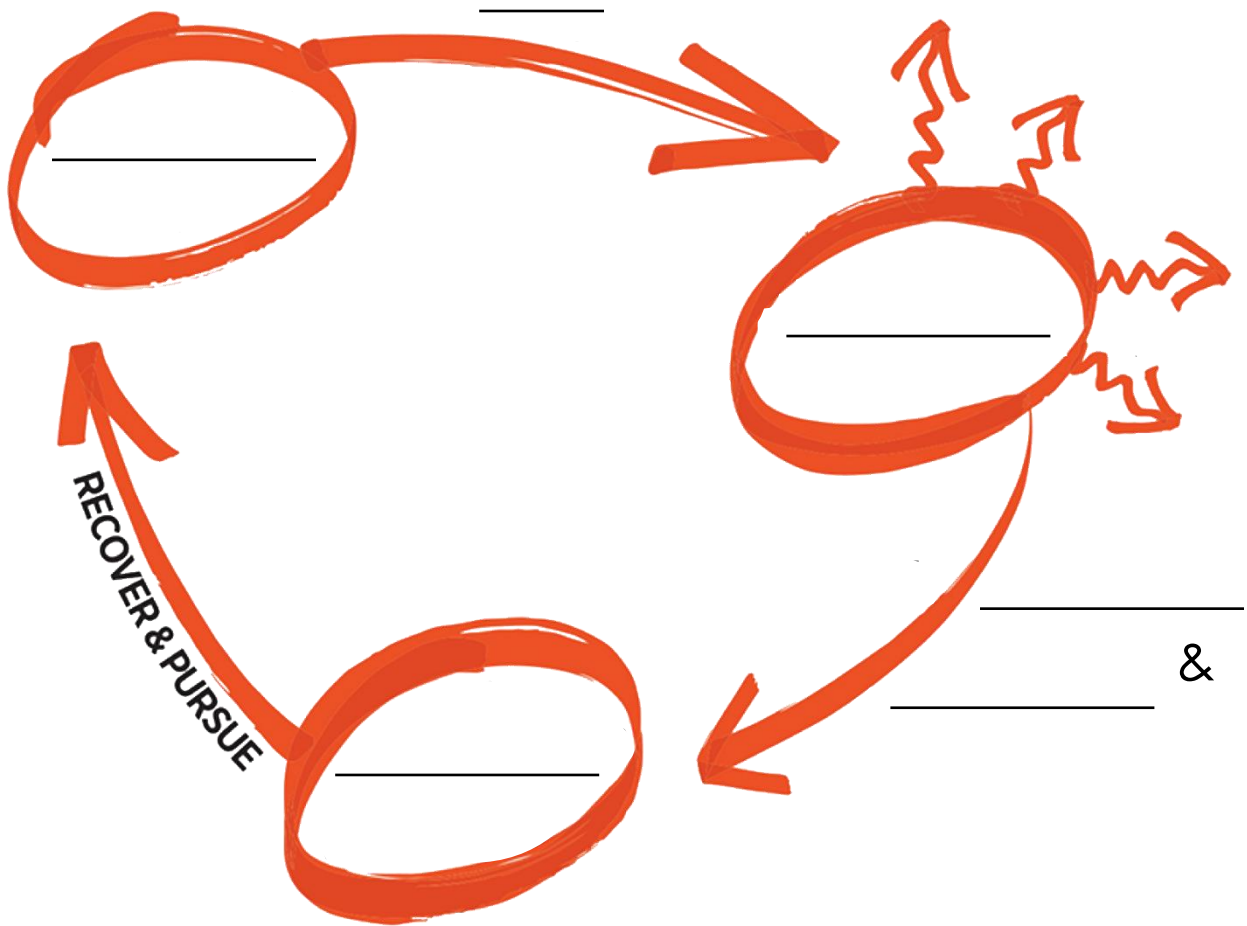
## Life On Mission: Week 4 ~ September 19, 2021

- The gospel is the good news that God has done everything necessary to save us.
- Repentance means acknowledging that Jesus is the Lord.
- Faith means believing Jesus did what He said He did when He finished the work of our salvation on the cross and embracing that as your own.
- There is no comprehension of the gospel without a comprehension of sin.
- Two prayers: (1) As You have been to me, so I will be to others. (2) I'll measure Your compassion by the cross and Your power by the resurrection.
- Effective evangelists believe two things: (1) Salvation belongs to God. (2) Faith comes only by hearing the word of God.

Key Scriptures: Genesis 1-3; John 20:14-17; John 20:22; Exodus 20:3-17; Romans 1:25; Matthew 4:17; Luke 4:18-19, 43; Ephesians 5:25; Psalm 126:5; Romans 10:17; Romans 1:16

- 5) How does our understanding of the gospel influence our ability to live life on mission?

*Close your time together by spending time with your prayer/accountability partner. Lift your "one" in prayer. Pray that seeds are planted in their life. Pray that you have the opportunity to plant and water some in your efforts to share the Gospel with them.*
